Jan started rosemaling in 1980 and has taken classes both in the United States and in Norway. She has won awards at the at the Indiana State Fair, the Illinois Norsk Rosemalers Association, Sons of Norway, Stoughton Rosemaling Club, and Vesterheim Norwegian American Museum in Decorah, Iowa. Jan and her husband have owned and operated Turn of the Century Wood Products in Thorntown, IN, since 2002. They sell their unfinished wood products to decorative artists all over the world. - Information from the Indiana Artisan website.

Our project for this class is a mangle board in the Vest Agder style of rosemaling. At one time mangle boards had both a practical and a romantic use in Norwegian culture. They were often given as proposal gifts by suitors and were used by the new bride to press clothing before irons. The Vest Agder style of rosemaling originated in what is now part of the Agder county at the very southern tip of Norway.
