

# Demystifying Design for Rosemalers: Telemark Style

Would you rather have a root canal than create a Telemark design? Come and learn some ideas to help you with designing. (PSSST....what you learn here you can use to learn designing of other styles). Designing is systematic, in other words, there are steps to the process. You first learn it in your head, next your hand, finally you are designing and painting from the heart.

The INRA looks to Vesterheim Gold Medalist Patti Goke to demystify design for us in this combination Zoom and Independent Study class taking place the week of November 6-13. **This class includes three Zoom sessions and additional independent time outside of class.** The approximate number of hours of independent work time between the class sessions is up to the individual. The more you put into it, the more you get out of it.

**Our Zoom sessions will be as follows:**

1. November 6: 9:00 - 11:30 am Central and
2. November 6: 12:30 - 3:00 pm Central
3. November 13: 9:00 - 11:30 am Central (the number of hours this day depends on the number of class participants) This is a time to go over designs created by students during the week giving everyone about 6 minutes plus time for questions. Students should plan on working independently on rosemaling design in between each Zoom session. That is, from 9 am-5 pm on the first Saturday there will be independent work expected to be completed between Zoom sessions, in addition to the independent design time during the week. Students are asked to email Patti their design work on Friday, Nov. 12 by noon to be discussed in class on Saturday, Nov. 13. The goal of the Saturday session is to give students a week of time to design some work, to then come back to the class for discussion and feedback.

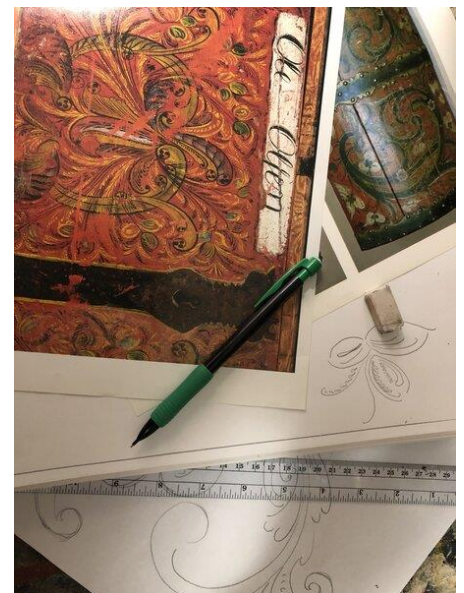
