

INRA Hallingdal Zoom Class with Lise Lorentzen



The Illinois Norsk Rosemalers Association will have Lise Lorentzen of Bel Air, Maryland, teach a Hallingdal class on September 23 - 25, 2022, via Zoom. The project piece is an original design collaborative work. Lise is painting an original design on a handled stepstool created by Mike Lusk. After careful consideration this class is switching to the Zoom format. Class instruction will include demonstration, painting time, and individual feedback. The class project will be demonstrated in both acrylics and oils. Class sessions will be held Friday from 6:30 – 9:30PM, Saturday from 9:00AM - 5:30PM with an hour for lunch, and Sunday from 12:30PM to 3:00PM.

Pattern packets with pictures, line drawings, and step by step instructions are included in the price of the class and will be emailed to students. Lise will be teaching in acrylics, but students may use acrylics or oils as they prefer. Both acrylic and oil paint palettes will be provided in the packet.

Please order the Mora handled stepstool from Mike Lusk as you are able. Woodenware may not arrive in time for class. You are encouraged to combine your order with another student if possible as the shipping cost stays the same whether Mike puts 1 or 2 stools in a box, that charge being \$20.00 per box, unless you are not within the service area of Speedee Delivery and another courier is needed.



Information about the change in class format will be available tomorrow for the public in order to fill the class. Class registration will end when the class is full. A supply list will be sent by email with confirmation of registration. Pattern packets will be emailed directly to enrolled students as quickly as possible. Woodenware is to be ordered by each student from Mike Lusk and shipped to student for project completion. Woodenware delivery for class is not guaranteed. Artist's bio - Lise Lorentzen has been rosemaling since the age of 12 and her art covers over 30 years of experience, specializing in custom painting of woodenware, furniture, and home interiors. Lise has been fortunate to study under many renowned Norwegian and American artists. Before moving to Maryland, Lise completed the New York State Council of the Arts (NYSCA) folk arts apprenticeship program studying with master artist Eldrid Arntzen, a National Endowment of the Arts recipient. She has also studied and taught Rosemaling at the Fletcher Farm School for the Arts and Crafts in Ludlow, Vt. for 20+ years.

In November of 2017 Lise started recording rosemaling videos for her Facebook page, <https://www.facebook.com/ArtofLise1/>. She started a YouTube channel, [Rosemaling by Art of Lise](#), in July of 2019, and taught her first online class, for the INRA, in July of 2020. She taught three classes for the INRA in 2021 and this will be her third class for the INRA this year. Lise is a member of and teacher through Vesterheim, a Norwegian-American Museum in Decorah, IA, and competes in the museum's annual folk-art competition. This year Lise won a red ribbon and honorable mention at the 2022 National Norwegian-American Folk Art Exhibition, and she also won first and second place at the 2022 Sons of Norway District 3 competition. Lise's second place piece in the Sons of Norway competition was the Gudbrandsdal candleplate she taught for the INRA this past spring. This class was so popular that she taught two sections for us, and she has taught two more sections of the class through [rosemalingclasses.com](#). Lise is a popular and sought-after teacher/artist. We are delighted to have her with us in-person!
