
Illinois Norsk Rosemalers Association Rosemaling Basics with Julie Anderson



The Illinois Norsk Rosemalers Association is excited to have Julie Anderson teach a Basic Rosemaling Techniques class for six weeks in January and February 2023, via Zoom. This class is open to anyone who wants to learn to do Rosemaling or improve their painting skills. This is an overview class to teach and practice the basics. Class instruction will include lecture, demonstration, painting time, and individual feedback. Learn about supplies, backgrounding, strokework, linework, color theory, design, and decorative techniques plus much more! Students may paint with acrylic or oil paints. Class sessions will be held on Wednesday nights from 6:30-9PM, January 11, 18 and 25, and February 8, 15 and 22, 2023.

A supply list will be sent by email with confirmation of registration. Class materials will be available via Google Drive to enrolled students prior to the first night of class. This is not a project class. Students may paint on practice boards or paper using the medium of their choice. Options will be discussed in the supply list. INRA members will have one week for advanced registration for this class. Information about the class will be available on the INRA website and Facebook page as well as <u>rosemalingclasses.com</u> for the public starting December 11. Class registration will end when the class is full.

Bio for Julie Anderson:

I have been teaching Rosemaling since 1998 and love to share Rosemaling with others and be part of the Rosemaling community. In the fall of 2020, I started teaching virtually. I teach mainly in the Hallingdal, Telemark and Os styles with a focus on techniques and helping students learn how to interpret old work, color, design and ways to express themselves in their painting. However, I paint and have taught other styles of folk art, such as Swedish Dalamalning/Kurbits and German Bauernmalerei, and have studied with American, Norwegian and Swedish artists who paint these styles.
