Illinois Norsk Rosemalers Association Trondelag Tray class with Louise Bath



The Illinois Norsk Rosemalers Association is excited to have Louise Bath (VGM) teach a four-week Trondelag Tray class on April 15, 22 and 29, and May 6. The class project, a 16" oval tray, will be demonstrated in oils. Class sessions will be held from 9AM-noon, Central, each Saturday.



As can be seen in the accompanying pictures there are various rosemaling design styles found in the Trondelag area of Norway. The earliest seen are symmetrical floral ale bowls inspired by the renaissance period. The second are the Horne School vine scroll designs painted with Regency influences. The scrolls are painted in blue, on a light background and framed in green and red. The third is the Horne school bright red floral designs surrounded by shaded blue leaves, often in a vase. The fourth style is elegant scrolls with acanthus leaves along each side as seen in the Vikastuga in Sverresborg Museum. The fifth is seen in North Trondelag. Large flowers in red and white are framed with black leaves on a green or blue background.

We will be painting an oval tray with a design using the third and fourth Trondelag styles combined. Blue scrolls emerge from a small vase and wander sideways with acanthus leaves on each side of the scroll. Five types of bright flowers emerge from these and are surrounded by realistic shaded leaves and teardrops. In the class Louise will be giving painting instruction and demonstrating the different painted elements of the tray. Louise will also be covering the history and various Trondelag styles as well as showing examples from her collection of photos.

Artist Biography:

Louise Bath first took rosemaling classes in Denver over 30 years ago, but it was her first class at Vesterheim in 2005 that started her on the journey to a Vesterheim Gold Medal, which she was awarded in 2017. She has been teaching rosemaling at the Trollheim Sons of Norway Lodge, in Lakewood Colorado, since 2012 and for Vesterheim since 2017. Three trips to Norway (2013, 2016 and 2018) have given her a wealth of rosemaling knowledge and ideas. Completing a certificate in Botanical Art and Illustration from the Denver Botanic Gardens in 2017 has added to her knowledge of technique



and composition. She strives to give her rosemaling students not only a grounding in painting techniques, but also a review of the history and examples of the regional style.
